Wasn’t it God who first confused the tongues at Babel? Many say Hebrew is our Lord’s tongue. I beg to differ. One heaven and one firmament speak to all tongues at once; *“there is NO speech or language where their Voice is not heard!”* Their Voice is the Voice of God and He Speaks the language of thought. In what language do you think? The “more intelligent than thou” mindset of self-important scholars, priests and pastors destroys the confidence of less learned believers and causes them to think they must learn of men rather than of God the Holy Spirit, Himself! *“The Anointing which ye have received of Him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same Anointing Teacheth you of ALL things, and is Truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in Him. The Spirit of Truth Is Come; He Will Guide you into all Truth.”* The Holy Spirit Reveals Truth to your soul and Guides your daily walk through faith in His Word. Why don’t missionaries teach Hebrew instead of translating the Bible into other languages? God Speaks Truth to your heart in your mother tongue. He has *“Published to ALL the people!”* Yes, Scripture was first given to the Hebrews, but Paul wrote in Greek to the Gentile churches. If God meant His Word to be only understood in Hebrew, why did the Apostles write in Greek? I knew and loved God long before I knew Hebrew and I still know very little. You may feel more spiritual to know or use Hebrew, but it doesn’t make you holier. What makes you Holy is the Blood of Jesus Christ and His Work, as the Holy Spirit, Prompting obedience to Truth through faith; the GIFT of God which cometh by the Word of God! God’s Word is to *“every generation,”* no exceptions!

God speaks fluent Swahili, Chinese, English, and etc., because He created them in the first place! No discredit given to the study of ancient languages and texts. God gave men and women down through the centuries the ability to understand and translate from Hebrew, Greek, and Aramaic into other tongues or we would not have the KJV, La Reina, or the Asian and indigenous tribal language Scriptures to which many have dedicated lifetimes of linguistic work!
