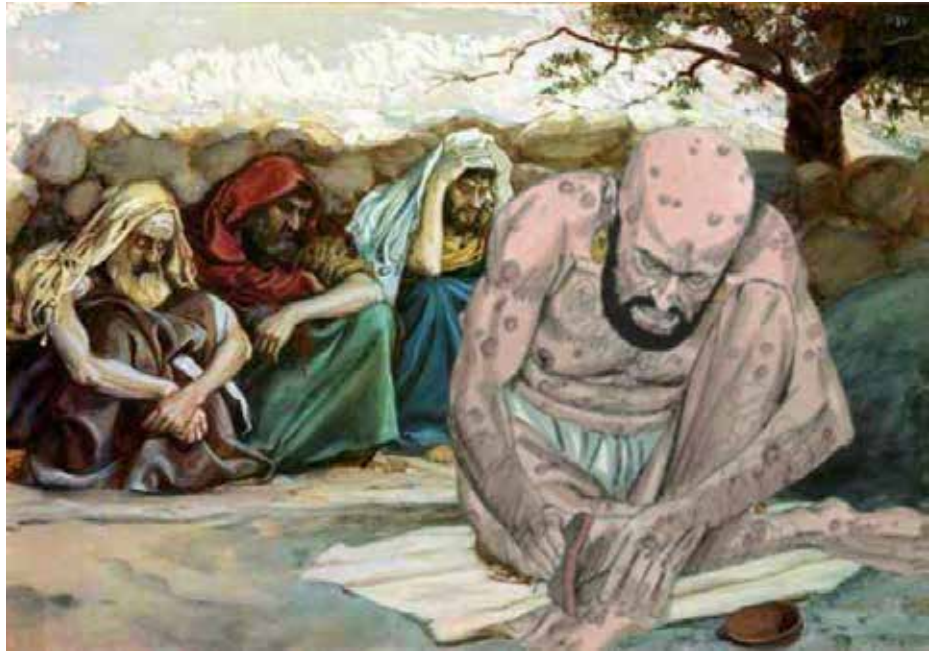

However, even in the midst of tribulation Job retained his integrity for his strength was not of himself, but from the invisible God Who Stood with him!
