


“And He remembered for them His covenant, and repented according to the multitude of His mercies.” Psalms 106:45 KJV

How oft in a day do we relinquish our grasp of Truth to satisfy a momentary lust? One of the most well known, basic commands of the New Testament is, *“Pray without ceasing!”* But do we? I plead guilty to the charge! Our most earnest prayer ought to be, *“Lord, teach me to pray without ceasing!”* It may bring a plethora of trials, but you will learn to pray. Some may think, *“Why would I want more troubles?”* But you would be missing the point: To walk in constant continuous intimacy with Eternity's Sovereign! Trouble would vanish and trials would be no more bother to you than bumblebees to a flower. Repentance would be a reflex, Truth your armour, and Love your purpose! We would rest in dreams of His everlasting Love and rise to the sound of His Voice! God mercifully forgives the wretched beggars who call upon Him because of His righteous and Holy character. He remembers all of His purposes and promises to men in spite of their blasphemous unbelief! *“If we believe not, yet He abideth faithful: He cannot deny Himself.”* It is HIS nature that is flawless, HIS love that is everlasting, and HIS covenant that is unbreakable! In the dawn of time God covenanted with Himself to perform a work that would salvage the unsalvageable; Love the unlovable; and redeem the unredeemable! Believers can rest secure *“in hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began,”* because He *“changes not! Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever! [His] Word...is forever settled in Heaven.”* There is nothing good, pleasing, or satisfying in your life except it came from God! God's covenant will be kept, not because you claim His promises, but because He keeps them for His own sake. *“Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast.”* The two *“immutable things”* are God and His Word. What He says; forever is! Men have no influence on whether or not God keeps His promises! When you pray, repeat God's promises, and make sure you have met the conditions of that promise. *“And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, (promises) He heareth us.”*
