"O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me." God knows everything about you. "{2} Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off." He knows beforehand what you are going to think and do. "{3} Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways." I have no actions, quirks, or habits hidden from God. "{4} For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether." God even knows why we say what we do even when we don't know why. "{5} Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me." My path is predetermined, because my choices are already known to God. "{6} Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it." God's wisdom is beyond man's ability to fathom. "{7} Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?" There is nowhere to hide from God. "{8} If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. {9} If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; {10} Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me. {11} If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me. {12} Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee." God is everywhere. "{13} For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb." Even helpless, God protects and guides me. "{14} I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well." Physicians simply give aid to the body that God created to heal itself. "{15} My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. {16} Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them." Each person is a recorded entity before conception. "{17} How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! {18} If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee." Man will never sound the depths of God's knowledge. "{19} Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men. {20} For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain. {21} Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? And am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? {22} I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies." It is good to hate evil. Avoid unrighteous men. Their perdition is sealed. "{23} Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: {24} And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."
