Why were you not satisfied? Someone once asked a very rich man, "How much money is enough money?" He quickly replied, "Just a little more!" Why does satisfaction seem so elusive? You eat and are full and yet later you're again hungry. It is the same with everything else. God's Word Says, *"Four things say not, 'It is enough:' The grave; and the barren womb; the earth that is not filled with water; and the fire. There is a generation, whose teeth are as swords, and their jaw teeth as knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from among men. Yea, they are greedy dogs which can never have enough."* There's even a rock song that celebrates, "I can't get no satisfaction!" There is only one thing that will ever bring you the fullness of Eternal Satisfaction: A loving relationship with your Creator! Everything else is like trying to catch a shadow in the dark! It slips out of your grasp before you know it's gone! God's Promises Are Absolute for eternity. *"So Shall My Word Be that Goeth Forth out of My Mouth: It Shall Not Return unto Me void, but It Shall Accomplish That Which I Please, and It Shall Prosper in the thing whereto I Sent It."* If God Said It, That Settles It!

There is a word that is kindred to satisfied; that is, the word contented. Contentment or satisfaction is the result of fleeing the temptation of covetousness. We desire what we see if not perceived in the Light of Truth. God's Word gives us the understanding that desire for wealth is evil. *"The love of money is the root of all evil. Thou shalt not covet."* To desire what God has not yet provided or has removed from us is a lack of trust or unbelief. *"No GOOD thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly. He that Spared Not His Own Son, but Delivered Him Up for us all, how Shall He not with Him also Freely Give us all things?"* It's a rhetorical question. Father Knows Best, because He Knows the thoughts, intents, choices, and deeds of all men AND the future of all time! You can be satisfied He will do the very best for you!
