


"Turn you at my Reproof: behold, I will pour out my Spirit unto you, I will make known my Words unto you. Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded; But ye have set at nought all my Counsel, and would none of my Reproof: I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh; When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me: For that they (fools) hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD: They would none of my Counsel: ***They Despised All My Reproof.***" Proverbs 1:23-30 KJV



We must fear God to love Him. His Mercy, Grace, and Love would hold no value if we at first did not acknowledge His Wrath, Power, and Presence. "*The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.*" Only a fool would stand and laugh at a charging bear! "*Fools make a mock at sin [and] a companion of fools shall be destroyed.*" There is an old saying that holds to this Truth; "Fools rush in where angels fear to tread!" Therefore repenting is a return to obedience. "*ALL have sinned.*" The good news is, "*God commendeth His Love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. And He is the Propitiation (atoning sacrifice) for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. Hereby we do know that we know Him, IF we [obey] His [Word].*" Sin is the bane of us all, but obedience and the consistent return thereto are the evidence of true faith.
