What scribes memory upon the soul? First, you must choose to ponder. Secondly, you must choose what you think. How do I choose a particular mindset be in my psyche? By thinking about it. Opinion or belief is formed through meditation or pondering something. Experiences affect us by becoming part of thought. Some more than others. Without memory, life would have little or no effect on decisions. What you LET yourself think about effects how you act. Thirdly, you must believe or deny what you think about. Denial is not "not thinking" of something, it's refusing to believe and act upon what you are thinking about. I can't deny something without thinking about it and I cannot ponder something that doesn't exist. The word "a-theist" means, "against God." They say they don't believe there's a God. But how can you be against something that isn't? Since there is no such thing as a "driub," an "adriub" cannot exist. Your thoughts determine your character and deeds. *"As he thinketh in his heart, so is he. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and IF there be any praise, THINK on these things."* If you just let any old idea flit through your mind you will become a flibbertigibbet. You'll be impulse driven instead of purpose driven. Fourthly, to succeed in life you must be purpose driven. There is no higher purpose than the search for and application of absolute Truth! *"Thy Word is Truth."* Scientists are driven by pursuit of knowledge, but they intertwine human reason with absolutes and neglect the Truth which makes perfect sense of the universe! *"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom."* Their flawed theories convolute their conclusions making them fools! Those who worship manmade images fall into the same category! *"Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things."* Men who place their own reason above God's Word damn themselves. *"And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, (Abandoned in sin; lost to virtue or grace) to do those things which are not convenient."*

To write the Truth upon the heart,  
The Truth from thought must never part,  
Like potter's mark on softened clay,  
The fire of God doth make it stay! -CGP

First, *"He that cometh to God MUST BELIEVE that He is, AND that He is a rewarder of them that DILIGENTLY SEEK Him."* Secondly, *"STUDY to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth."* Thirdly, *"LET (choose) this mind (purpose) be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus."* Fourthly, you must simply do it. *"Happy are ye if ye DO them. Hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep (obey) His commandments."* Thinking about it, never built anything!
