His Infinite Supply is our warehouse. He Favors the willing heart. If God's Favor is your treasure, your obedience will be automatic. After all that Job went through, he said, "Blessed be the Name of the Lord." If we love God, we will trust Him, no matter what befalls. God Is Forever Merciful And Gracious to the rebellious sons of Adam. When He Could Have Destroyed all and begun anew, He Offered Pardons to the penitent and Gifts to the humble. His Word Is the Fulcrum of the Grace that levers the fallen into Newness of Life. If we could just grasp a tiny bit of the enormity of Eternal Life, we would "forsake all and follow Him." Nothing would dampen our zeal or quell our praise! Flames could not silence the martyrs. They sang their way into the Heavens. A Vision of Glory Bore Away their suffering on gossamer wings of Grace. If we could but glimpse the object of their zeal, revival would begin and the Power of the Gospel would Cause sinners to grab for support out of sheer terror!
