

*"I and my Father are one." John 10:30 KJV*

There are many who refuse to believe in the oneness of the God-head even though written in God's Word. From Christ's own lips we have a testimony to "The Father, The Son," and "The Holy Spirit" as distinct entities, but He also constantly affirmed His oneness with the Father. The Jews were going to stone Him for blasphemy, because He proclaimed Himself Jehovah. God's names are interchangeable, but ALL carry the same authority. To my children I am "Dad;" to my grandchildren I am "Pop-pop;" to my wife I am "Gale;" to my late father I was "Jughead;" and so on. I respond equally to each, but who I am remains constant. There is probably one name that you prefer. God

has given the name of "Jesus" that special preference. He prefers that name to all others. It does not mean that His other names carry no authority. The late John R. Rice was holding a meeting and he began and ended the service with prayer. Afterwards, a zealous young preacher addressed him on the subject of prayer. "Dr. Rice, we're supposed to pray to the Father through the Holy Spirit in the name of Jesus. I noticed you spoke directly to each." Dr. Rice, a big man, looked down over his glasses at the young man and replied, "Son, I've been in the family for years, so I just talk to everyone at the table." Did that mean Dr. Rice believed in three Gods? Anyone who has heard him preach or read any one of his many books knows that is not true, and neither do I. Jesus is the Son of God just like Adam was the son of God; meaning, God created the human form of both. The difference is Adam was only a "living soul" after God breathed into him and Jesus IS the "Living God. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us." Jesus is no more less from God than your body is not you. "In Him (Jesus) dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead BODILY." The body is your visible presence. Your body, soul (mind/thoughts), and spirit may act independently of each other, but are always united. For example; you're driving your car, planning your vacation, and humming your favorite tune. Your body is performing a physical function, driving; your mind a soul function, planning a vacation; and your spirit a spiritual function, singing. In a finite way, you are in three different places at once. Does it surprise you an infinite God is this on an infinite scale? You are a soul with a body and spirit, "and these three are one." There's only one "you" and only one God!
