

Make as many excuses as you like, but there is no excuse for ignorance. All you need to avail yourself of the Holy Spirit's wisdom is to believe and know the Word of God. He will speak to you in your thoughts as you meditate on what you know. *"He will guide you into ALL Truth"* with the still small voice of Truth in your thoughts. Ignorance is a conscious choice. Wisdom is the reward of the diligent. *"But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him."* Do you have questions like, "Why, When, and How?" God knows every answer. Seek Him and your questions will be answered in His perfect time. *"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him."* The future will cease to be a mystery, because the Holy Spirit "will show you things to come." Stress and anxiety will dissolve, because the Truth of every situation will be made clear to you as you read, pray, and meditate. Knowing God must be your consuming passion if you would possess the wisdom of the ages. Once you have heard His "still small voice" in your thoughts, you will recognize it forever. Have you heard His Voice lately? Have you ever heard it at all? *"I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me."*
