

*“A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.” John 16:16 KJV*



When are we going to go, Dad? In a little while, son. How long is “a little while?” It’s relative to the parent’s time schedule, not the child’s. God seems to complete things in sevens.
