Spiritual Truth has never been hidden nor mysterious as some man-made religions would have you think. No university degree is necessary to know that God is and that He communicates with men who seek Him. *Those that seek me early shall find me. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth his handiwork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night showeth knowledge.
