

"Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound." Romans 5:20 KJV



When we sin, Satan browbeats us with guilt. We abandon our efforts to "walk in the Light," and heed the evil blasphemous whispers of, "What's the point?ö Why blasphemous? It denies the absolute Truth of *"Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin. For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world. I can do all things through Christ."* What we have to remember is there are three parts to öyou.ö Your body, your soul, and your spirit. After salvation, your spirit is born again of the Spirit of God and cannot sin. Your body, however, is *ösold under sinö* and will not be redeemed until the Resurrection. *öIn a twinkling of an eye, we shall all (believers) be changed.
