Believers KNOW they are God's children the same way a child KNOWS its mother and father; the same way you KNOW what your name is. It is knowledge acquired from countless interactive moments of affirmation. Your faith becomes weak if you do not daily drink at the Spring of Living Water and eat the Bread of Life. We do that by letting God's Word saturate our minds through reading, study, and meditation therein. *Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth. Guilt and pride prevent us from admitting our sin and neither is a valid excuse. We are like the child that hates to take a bath. It is vital for our soul to be cleansed from sin. If we have unconfessed sin, we have no fellowship with the Lord and no witness in our life that we are His child. Make sure that you are not hiding a *private* sin. Ask the Spirit to search your heart and reveal your sin so you can confess it, or Satan will wreak havoc with your faith. *Keep back Thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright. Siné reigned unto death; grace reign[s] through righteousness unto Eternal Life. What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God Forbid!* You have a choice, Dear Believer.
