However, some believers think it’s their duty, to point out other’s infractions. *“Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.”* None are without the carnal flesh. *“For ALL have sinned and come short.”* The closer you get to God the more repulsive your sin is! Criticism and gossip are wicked! *“A man that beareth false witness against his neighbour is a maul (sledgehammer), and a sword, and a sharp arrow.”* Gossip is saying anything that demeans another behind their back! *“A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.”* God sees every heart and knows every hidden secret. God is longsuffering, if He’s anything, but He’ll not withhold wrath or the consequences of sin indefinitely. Sin will destroy you and your family, or have you forgotten Achan? *“Achan...took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.”* Israel was cursed because of one man’s sin. Many are quick to say, “God Bless America,” forgetting this: His commands are His Blessings that lead to His bountiful provision! God Bless America? Are we not Blessed? Is not His Word freely available to all in the U.S., but how many seek to obey? Before pointing out a brother’s trespasses, remember our Lord’s command. *“Love one another, as I have loved you.”* Love perfects fellowship with our Lord and fellow believers. *“Have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.”* Right or wrong, *“If thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother.”* God is fully capable of handling every child. He knows and sees things you cannot. It is imperative believers *“esteem other better than themselves.
