

Jesus Christ is the "Word made flesh." God's Word was also written and preserved. "For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting; and His Truth (Word) endureth to ALL GENERATIONS." It is "written" for our perfection on the "fleshly tables of [our] hearts." Not the muscle that pumps blood, but rather upon our minds and souls.
