

“But the God of all Grace, who hath called us unto His Eternal Glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. To Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true Grace of God wherein ye stand.” 1 Peter 5:10-12 KJV



Jesus IS the “*true Grace of God!*” Eternity’s Sovereign, “*who only hath immortality, dwelling in the Light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see,*” donned a robe flesh to redeem those who forsook Him! The divine Light of

God’s dwelling place is so pure no man can approach or see it! Just think for a moment: Laser light will cut through steel, but it is only one spectrum of light! God IS Light! All spectrums at once and at fully infinite intensity! What would happen to a man in that Light? He that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed.*” Jesus is at once Saviour and Slayer! “*As it is written (Is. 8:13-14, 28:16, 45:17), ‘Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and Rock of offence: and WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH on Him shall not be ashamed.’ For the preaching of the Cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the Power of God. For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish: To the one we are the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of Life unto Life.*” You choose your destiny when you choose what to believe! You either believe “*the God which cannot lie,*” or you believe Satan’s lies, who “*was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the Truth, because there is no Truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.*” All that opposes God’s Word, even if only slightly, is a lie of Satan! “*Casting down imaginations (impulsive thoughts), and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity EVERY THOUGHT to the obedience of Christ (God’s Word made flesh).*” Man is purified of unbelief’s condemnation through God’s Word kept in the heart, mind, and soul. Jesus prayed, “*Sanctify them through Thy Word; Thy Word is Truth.*” Sin is unbelief! It will keep you from God’s Word, and leave you eternally in Death!

Only belief of Truth will free your eternal soul from eternal death. God’s Word is Truth! What you do IS what you believe! Obedience of God’s Word is the evidence you believe it. Your talk talks and your walk talks, but your walk is what you believe! If you disobey God’s Word without a second thought, YOU ARE NOT A BELIEVER! You can have your disobedient pleasure now, and die forever, or you can die to self, now, obey God, and live in

pleasure forever! Unbelief is the only sin that is truly unforgiveable! It says Truth's proclamation is a lie, making Truth the work of Satan which is utter blasphemy! *"All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy (making Truth a lie through unbelief) against the Holy Ghost (The Spirit of Truth) shall not be forgiven unto men...neither in this world, neither in the world to come."* You may blaspheme and God will forgive, but dying in unbelief, damns you for eternity!
