For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God. As the days of [Noah] were, so shall also the Coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that [Noah] entered into the Ark, and knew not until the Flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the Coming of the Son of man be. Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.”* THE KING IS SOON ARRIVING!
