"And God Looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted His Way upon the earth. And God Said unto Noah, 'The end of all flesh is come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I Will Destroy them with the earth. Make Thee An Ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the Ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch." Genesis 6:12-14 KJV

These are perilous times for Faith. "By Faith Noah, being Warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an Ark to the saving of his house." God, Faith, and the faithful, have become the targets of extreme,



unreasonable hatred. Religions of hate, works, and self are enslaving men by leaps and bounds on the planet! Pitch is vital in wooden boats. Steel hulls are welded. Tiny leaks eventually sink any boat. Dry docks are used regularly to clean and scrutinize boat hulls for leaks. They even use x-rays on steel hulls to find hidden weaknesses. God's Word is the dry dock for Life and Faith is the pitch! Sin will seep in unnoticed through cracks of doubt while apathy rusts our Faith! We must seal doubt with faithful obedience: "Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience The Race that Is Set before us: Looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our Faith;" and keep apathy's rust away with constant prayer and confession. "Pray without ceasing. If we confess our sins, He Is Faithful And Just To Forgive...And Cleanse." Are your seams sealed? Does doubt allow sin to sink you? Are you "moved with fear" of God's Coming Wrath or does "the fear of man" snare you with apathy? Do you regularly "dry dock" in God's Word?
