Have you ever listened to the surf's whisper? It is heard above all other sounds, but still it is peaceful. Do you know God's Voice? If we walk with Him constantly, meditating, thinking, day and night in His Word, we will instantly know His "Voice." What "voice" do you "hear" when you read a friend's letter? Keep God's Word in your thoughts constantly to affect thought, reaction, and deed or else Satan will! His impulses aimed at our lusts are the "fiery darts of the wicked." He entices our sinful desires. Millennia of observation have taught him well which desires master us. He manipulates mankind to affect their destruction. You need look no further than the advertising industry. What commercials seem to come on at dinnertime? Why? Satan does not have to hurt us. He knows Divine Law better than anyone. He only has to tempt us to sin! God's Predetermined Consequences take care of the rest. "The soul that sinneth, it shall die." Satan entices with prosperity, pleasure, and power. His darts come in the form of impulse or intense desire. How many times have you uttered an angry thought, or acted impulsively or obsessively to regret it later? Where did it come from? Action and speech originate in thought. God has Wonderfully Programmed some actions as reflexes. A hot stove needs no thought to quickly move your hand away. Anything contrary to God's Word is sin. Thought is from ourselves, Satan, or God, the Holy Spirit. Since all thoughts have our "voice," the only way to know the source is to be intimate with Truth. God's Word Is A "Discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart!" God's Voice Is A Whisper of Truth to His Own.
