"But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, 'Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the LORD his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper. Are not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? May I not wash in them, and be clean?' So <u>He Turned And Went Away In A Rage</u>." 2 Kings 5:11-12 KJV

Naaman, second only to the King of Syria, presumed everyone was at his beck and call. He had little respect for the man of God, let alone God. He arrogantly assumed that Elijah would do as he desired, little realizing that as a leper and the commander of the army that had slaughtered and made slaves of many Hebrews, he was an abomination to every one of them. First, Naaman had to obey. Not something he normally did. It mattered little the river or the number of dips. Complete obedience was required. Leprosy left him after the 7th dip.
