

"And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, that Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison; And he spake kindly to him, and set his throne above the throne of the kings that were with him in Babylon; And changed his prison garments: and he did eat bread continually before him all the days of his life. And his allowance was A Continual Allowance Given Him Of The King, a daily rate for every day, all the days of his life." 2 Kings 25:27-30 KJV

We don't serve seven breakfasts on Monday morning. They are not needed nor could they be eaten. One is enough. One staff is enough for walking. A bundle would be a burden. "A continual allowance" means, I have enough for today and tomorrow will be supplied. Like a pension, it is automatic and on time, but unlike a pension, it is a gift, not an earned stipend. Believers Are Promised, "Seek ye first The Kingdom of God and His Righteousness and ALL these things shall be added unto you." Supper may be served and you may be welcome to it, but you must come to the table! God's Commands Are The Blessings That Furnish our path with Provision. If you don't obey God, don't complain of lack. It's your own fault! God Has Given Specific Instructions on how to collect your daily allowance and if you fail to comply don't expect to receive. Would your boss pay you if you never showed up and why would you even think you deserved it? Many have received government handouts for so long they consider them a right. They do nothing to earn them, but still demand them while hardworking men and women are overtaxed to provide them. We deplore this total lack of regard and responsibility, but we treat God the same way! We covet and desire to have, but do nothing to merit even the slightest crumb from God! Jesus our, KING of kings, Has Promised to "Give us this day our daily bread," if we but ask. We deplore our lack, but "ye have not, because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts." We need to "ask in Faith, nothing wavering. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord." Why do we ask and do we ask only for today? If we have leftovers, we have too much. Leftovers are given to me to give away, not hoard. Hoarding is a lack of Faith and trust. It means I don't believe God Will Supply my need tomorrow even though He Gave me more than I needed, today. God doesn't step out of the ether and magically materialize our daily needs. He Uses people with means, to supply people without them.

If believers would just prove God with legitimate requests, their trust levels would escalate, stress would disappear, and their time could be spent with the KING and His Business without a care or concern for any transient calamity of life.
