

***LORD, Make Me To Know** mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is; that I may know how frail I am.” Psalms 39:4no2 KJV*

Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, And be found in Him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the Law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: That I may know Him, and the Power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being made conformable unto His death.” If we are not prepared to lay our LIVING on the line for God, we don’t really love Him! “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a LIVING sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.” Our body becomes our enemy the moment we repent and until Christ returns, it will be the main source and tool of conflict for believers.
