"My tears have been my meat day and night, while they continually say unto me, 'Where is thy God?" Psalms 42:3 KJV

Or whither shall I flee from Thy Presence? If I ascend up into heaven, Thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, Thou art there. If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea: Even there shall Thy Hand lead me, and Thy Right Hand shall hold me. If I say, 'Surely the darkness shall cover me;' even the night shall be light about me. Yea, the darkness hideth not from Thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to Thee." In the depths of your darkest woes, God is already there and knows how you feel! "For consider Him that endured such contradiction of sinners against Himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, YET WITHOUT SIN. Let us therefore come boldly unto the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need." Are you in need? God's Word is your portal to "peace that passeth ALL understanding!"
