

“Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me. Yet the LORD will command his lovingkindness in the daytime, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life.”
Psalms 42:7-8 KJV

Color is indistinguishable in the darkness. Our eyes are reduced to, essentially, light or no light. Faith is the believer’s headlights. *“Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet...a light unto my path.”* The light of God’s Word allows us to see nuances of color, direction, and light unseen by unbelievers in the darkness of unbelief; *“in whom the god of this world hath blinded [their] minds...lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ...should shine unto them.”* Unbelief is a choice, not a condition! Doing declares faith, but it does not gain faith! *“Not by works of righteousness which we have done.”* However, faith will produce works. *“Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. A man is not justified by...works...but by the faith of Jesus Christ.”* And *“the faith of Jesus Christ”* will produce righteous works. You can’t walk the right path without light. Your car has headlights, but they do not shine all the way home! They only illuminate the piece of road ahead so you may steer correctly. The road signs reflect them and tell you where to go. You can’t see all the way home, but you know by the clearly lit signs how much further it is. Without *“the faith of Jesus Christ,”* you’ll miss Heaven’s exit in this life and there is no turn around in the next! Believers have Christ as our light; clearly defining the path ahead and guiding us home! *“Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the Hope of Glory. The Spirit of Truth...will guide you into all Truth...He will shew you things to come.”* Even in the night of sin believers will know when Home is close – the signs will tell us so, because they reflect the *“glorious light”* of God’s Word!
