Its oil is a chef's favorite and is also used for healing and light. Olives, green or ripe, grace many elegant tables. In the olive tree we find a parallel to the believer. Our sustenance may not be apparent to the observer, but it will be manifested by our life and fruit of our actions. "Rooted and built up in Him, [Christ] and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving." To this day we partake of the fruit of believers like Paul, Peter, Daniel, John, Isaiah, Moses, and many others like Tyndale, Wycliffe, Bunyan, Livingston, and Elliot, who gave their lives in testimony to the "Living Water" they had found in the barren landscape of temporal life. Is your life "a green olive tree" bearing undisputable testimony to the invisible Spirit who is the eternal God? "That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word." Does the fruit of your labor grace the world? Your words give healing and light? "Being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life." Does your conversation invite others to partake of eternal Life? Does your fruit bear seed that grows in good ground? Can seekers find "Christ in you? The Hope of Glory?"
