"Cast Thy Burden Upon The LORD, and He shall sustain thee: He shall never suffer the righteous to be moved." Psalms 55:22 KJV

What preponderance of circumstance weighs on your soul this day? What winds of events whip your heart into waves of unrest? We cast those cares upon the Lord by trusting in God's Word in spite of doubt and fear. Is your vessel tossed about? Remember Who it is that is present with you and focus on His Power and Peace instead of the storm. "Great Peace have they which love Thy Law and nothing shall offend them." Believers are sustained by the "Everlasting Father;" carried in His arms through the treacherous waters of temporal life to the shores of eternal bliss. "The Eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the Everlasting Arms: Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me." If we carry our

If we follow and trust the Master of the tempest and gaze fearlessly upon Him Whom even the winds and waves obey. That which drowns the wicked becomes Solid Rock beneath us through faith! Satan desperately roars about us with circumstance to destroy our Peace and distract our faith from the Power which our focus upon Truth imbues us. It is only when we look away from Truth that care and woe cause us doubt. If our gaze is filled with Father's Omnipotence and Love, we'll tread the tempest beneath our feet while others drown! Only fools dare threaten those carried in the arms of Eternity's Sovereign!
