"Blessed be the Lord, who <u>daily</u> loadeth us with <u>benefits</u>, even the God of our salvation. Selah." Psalms 68:19 KJV

"Loaded" has the sense of "more than can be handled easily." We say, "We are loaded down with work; or care; or responsibility. It is seldom thought of in a positive way, but here God's Word indicates that God's benefits to men are a "daily" load. Not blessings, but benefits. God's commands are His blessings that lead us to His "daily benefit." Let us think for a moment: What are His benefits? Does God love and forgive you? Are you breathing? Did you wake? Have you clothing? Do you have food to eat? A shelter? A family? A job? An income? Count your daily benefits and remember



what God's Word says, "Having food and raiment, therewith be content." Jesus didn't tell us to ask God for tomorrow's needs. He said, "After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our DAILY bread." What were your daily benefits yesterday or the day before for which you have yet to thank God? Have you been threatened, persecuted, or injured for you faith? Many Christians are being beheaded for what they know is true by godless scum who froth profanities and bathe in atrocities with glee! They think themselves "God's servants." What will be going through their minds as they writhe in the black flames of eternal damnation? The faces and words of those they murdered? The worst agony of Hell will be knowing that you knew how to escape it, yet you rejected the Truth, and are there by your own choice! "Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? The goodness of God endureth continually. Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. Thou lovest evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah. Thou lovest all devouring words, O thou deceitful tongue. Despisest thou the riches of His goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? God shall likewise destroy thee forever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of thy dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah." Go ahead, turn your head from the Truth, neglect God's commands, and you will find yourself in Hell rubbing elbows with the depraved scum you thought yourself better than! Wickedness is choosing your way instead of what you know is God's way. If you can get and read a Bible and you do not, you have arrogantly neglected Truth! "The WICKED shall be TURNED INTO HELL, and ALL THE NATIONS THAT FORGET GOD!" Knowing Truth doesn't save you! Jesus saves you! He said, "My sheep know my voice and they follow me." If you disobey Truth, you are NOT one of His sheep! You will go into hell with your eyes wide open with no one to blame but yourself!
