"Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; there shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For He shall give His Angels charge over thee, To Keep Thee In All Thy Ways." Psalm 91:9-11 KJV

The prodigal son would not have had to return to home if he had never left. The reason we have troubles is, because we don't stay with God. Oh, we visit Him, but He is not our "habitation." He may even be a daily stop on our path, but He isn't where we eat and sleep; only where we go in emergencies; a hospital, if you will. If we would just stay home, instead of running off, like the prodigal son, God wouldn't have to keep looking for our return. Father gives us what we need, and then some, but if we keep on living "our way," we'll find ourselves feeding hogs and hungering for hog slop! Father has all we need and if we abide with Him we shall never lack! We can rest and relax in His Favor and Bountiful Substance. God's Provision isn't His Blessings His Commands are, because Provision lines the path of obedience! You don't find apples in a corn field, and you won't find God's Provision on the path of disobedience. "Be not deceived, God is not mocked; whatsoever a man soweth, that, shall he also reap." If you sow indifference,



apathy, negligence, and ignorance, you can expect to reap the same! Only those who run on the race course can expect to win the race! We wouldn't have to come home if we just LIVED with the KING.
