"The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow <u>like a cedar</u> in Lebanon. Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God." Psalm 92:12-13 KJV

Scripture tells us that God inhabits the praises of His people. "O my God...Thou art Holy, O Thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel." We are to enter into His courts with praise. "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His Name." We are to give thanks in every situation. "In everything give thanks [and] by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." When we ask God for



things, we must not appear to be ungrateful for what He has already provided. Believers can only thrive if rooted in adoration of the Blessed Redeemer. The Church, is the "Body of Christ." A body cannot function without a head. Many "Churches" try to do the work of the ministry "without a head." A headless body is only good for burying. The "Head" controls the "Body." Jesus said, "Without me, ye are nothing." We must be firmly rooted in God's Word if we are to grow like the cedar. This cannot happen without water. Water is the life of the tree and the Word is the Life of the Church of God. "Christ also loved the Church, and gave Himself for it; that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word, that He might present it to Himself a glorious church." The Church must praise and adore Jesus first and foremost if there is to be any effective ministry or work accomplished. Praise is the "bread and butter" of believers. It is basic to survival. "Praise bands" do not glorify God, they glorify the music. Psalms and hymns do not need drums. "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." Adoration for the Saviour is best played on worshipful lips. We'll never be blessed with God's presence in our hearts without His praise continually on our lips. Spontaneous affection is the most sincere. Praise the Lord!
