

*"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."
Proverbs 4:23 KJV*

The “keep” was the best guarded place in the entire castle. It was the most fortified and protected. It was usually high up in a tower with one easily defended stairway leading to it. It usually had one narrow window, and was located in the thickest part of the wall.
