

"Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? And one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows." Matthew 10:29-31 KJV



How many hairs are on our heads? We could scarcely count or number each hair of one person, let alone the millions of believers world-wide. If God is concerned enough about us to label each hair of our head, it stands to reason He would be aware of our most insignificant needs. Father's attention to detail is unequalled! Even the sparrows come under His care. If His hand is in the ministering of the daily needs of the sparrows, it is safe to assume that His care for us far exceeds that of the sparrow. He told us Himself that we *"are of more value than many sparrows."* A farthing was one of the smallest coins, (about 1.5 cents) and a sparrow was only worth half. *"Therefore take no thought, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or, 'What shall we drink?' or, 'Wherewithal shall we be clothed?' for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things."* God will never leave nor forsake His children. *"Lo, I am with you always, even until the end of the world."* He tenderly provides the needs of even the tiny sparrow and He will take care of you. *"Faithful is He that calleth you, who also will do it. If we believe not, yet He abideth faithful: He cannot deny himself. And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. Whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly."* Men's needs will never deplete God's infinite supply, because, after all, all He needs do is speak it into existence! *"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."* If it's good and you have it, God gave it. Are you thankful or do you just covet more? Are your needs taken care of for today? Then you have enough. Ask tomorrow for tomorrow. Tomorrow's needs are only today's covetous desires. *"Seek ye FIRST the kingdom of God and HIS righteousness and ALL THESE THINGS shall be added unto you."* If you don't believe and practice this, you are calling God a liar! *"And hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep (obey) His commandments. He that saith, 'I know Him,' and keepeth not His commandments, is a LIAR, and the Truth is not in him."* Do you claim to be a Christian? Do you obey God's Word?
