"For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." Matthew 18:20No2 KJV

Jesus referred to His Father as "witness" to the Truth of His Words. "The works... that I do bear witness of me...And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me." God is a plurality in the same sense that man is. "There are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one." You are a soul with a body and spirit, which function



independently of yet, harmoniously with one another. For example: You are driving, talking about your vacation plans, and listening to music. For Thou hast possessed my reins: Thou hast covered me in my mother's womb." I was a recognized person in God's eyes before I ever entered the womb. "My substance was not hid from Thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in Thy Book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them." God waits patiently, unseen, for our love. Our soul needs Him.

There is no place I can be that the Holy Spirit is not there. There is no pain or sorrow I can feel that Jesus does not know. "Seeing then that we have a great High Priest, that is passed into the Heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin." There is no need too great for Father to supply. "My God shall supply ALL your need. No good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly." A whispered, "I love you," carries more weight than a public proclamation. The Word of God whispered by the Holy Spirit to our soul reveals Father's Love. "My sheep hear my Voice."
