brought unto Him a penny. And He saith unto them, 'Whose is this image and superscription?' They say unto Him, 'Caesar's.' Then saith He unto them, 'Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God The Things That Are God's." Matthew 22:16-21 KJV
