

“And Jesus answered and said unto them, ‘Take Heed That No Man Deceive You. For many shall come in my name, saying, “I am Christ (Truth);” and shall deceive many.” Matthew 24:4-5no2 KJV



Are you depending on others for the Truth you believe, or do you read God's Word and know it for yourself? Men are born liars! *“They go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies. Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.”* Ever know a baby to
