"To whom also He shewed Himself alive after His passion by many <u>infallible</u> <u>proofs</u>, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:" Acts 1:3 KJV

The Apostles had forty days of intensive training after the resurrection of Christ. They were taught the things they later passed on in their writings. I believe Christ explained afore written Scripture to shew how they spoke of Himself, of the events they had already witnessed, and those things yet come. I believe Paul was trained



later. John was later given specific foresight into the end of days and the 70th week of Danieløs already written prophecy. Eyewitness testimony, a witnessed affidavit, and a death bed confession are accepted as irrefutable evidence in any courtroom. Forensic medicine proves men always leave their mark. They leave "infallible proofs" of their passing. Seeing is believing. After His resurrection, Jesus õwas seen of Cephas (Peter), then of the twelve: After that, He was seen of above five hundred brethren at once.ö A bevy of affidavits record His being alive after one of the cruelest deaths ever perpetrated upon a man. He ate, talked, recognized, and was recognized by close friends and acquaintances. His scars were seen and touched. More written evidence corroborates His resurrection than Christopher Columbus' voyage to the New World. The writers sealed their testimonies with martyrdom as Satan tried desperately to silence the Gospel! Jesus Himself said it best when He told of the rich man and Lazarus. The rich man; "in hell...lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. He said, 'Send Lazarus, I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.' Abraham saith unto him, 'They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.' And he said, 'Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.' And he said unto him, 'IF THEY HEAR NOT MOSES AND THE PROPHETS, NEITHER WILL THEY BE PERSUADED, THOUGH ONE ROSE FROM THE DEAD." Herein lies the Truth of unbelief. "Infallible proof" matters little, because men choose what they want to believe or disbelieve. You, yourself, believe exactly what you have decided to believe, no matter what your lips may profess or what proof you@ve been shown. Belief and trust are fixed by your own desires. \(\tilde{o}Delight \) thyself also in the LORD; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart.ö Godøs Word changes what you want.

> There is no proof can rescue men, If they decide to stay in sin, Your choices damn you in the end, Unless the Truth your Life defends! ~CGP

What you know to be true has no bearing whatsoever upon what you do unless you choose to allow it. This is why in so many places in God's Word the word "Let" is used. "Let your light so shine before men; Let your communication be, ¿Yea, yea; Nay, nay: Ø Who hath ears to hear, let him hear. If any man will come after me, let him deny himself. If any man thirst, let him come. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body. Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness. Let no man deceive himself. Let a man examine himself. Let all things be done decently and in order. Let this mind (Godøs Word) be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." You think, say, and do exactly what you choose! NO man will stand before God justified without Jesus! Your life proves your heart!
