
"Let This Mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." Philippians 2:5 KJV

Many believe and it is true to an extent, that you are what you think. The Truth is; what you think about will affect your choices, words and deeds. YOU choose to think WHAT you think! You alone are the master of your thoughts. Suggestions can be introduced, but you decide what the focus of your attention is. What actually goes through your mind? Words, pictures, ideas? God only rewards the "diligent" seeker! We seek God by choosing His Word as the focus of thought. Faith isn't faith unless it obeys. "This Book of the Law (God's Word) shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt MEDITATE (think) THEREIN DAY AND NIGHT (24/7), that thou mayest observe TO DO (obey) according to ALL that is



written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have GOOD success." You can have bad success as a result of bad choices. You can be successful at crime or sin, "but the end thereof are the ways of DEATH!" God's Word only brings good to the obedient believer, but you must know it to believe it. Why do you think Satan is so desperate to keep us from prayer and study of God's Word? Oh, he doesn't care about your little morning devotional reading, because he can quickly distract and direct your thoughts somewhere else with anything from phone calls to emergencies! This is why we must CHOOSE God's Word to be in our thoughts; it doesn't just magically happen: It must be diligently sought and thought! Note: What occupies your time, will occupy your thought.
