"Thou therefore <u>endure hardness</u>, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ." 2 Timothy 2:3 KJV

Pleasure is forsaken in the field of combat. Thoughts of home and hearth are pushed aside for the sake of survival. Scrapes, cuts, and bruises are worn with a sense of pride and disdain. There is no room for anything that will endanger the mission. Even sickness is inexcusable. Warriors must carry their own supplies and weapons, and tend to first aid for minor
